Black in colour with thin deep but definite white marks.



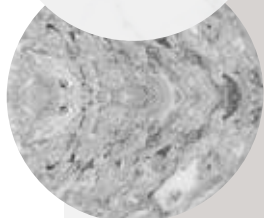
GREEN MARBLE

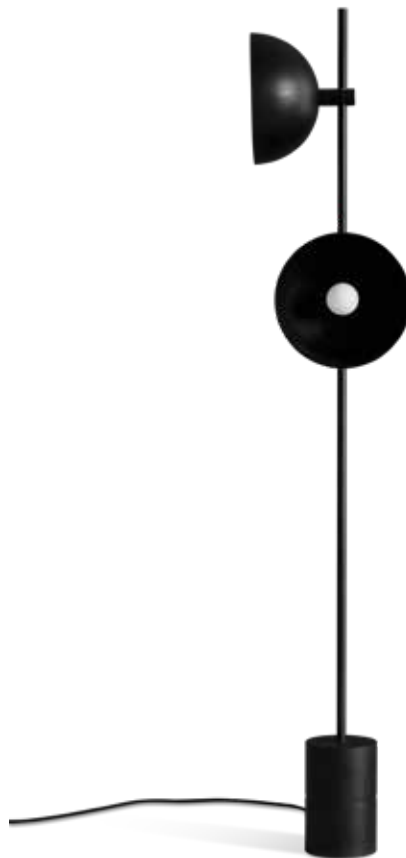


STUDIO FLOOR LAMP

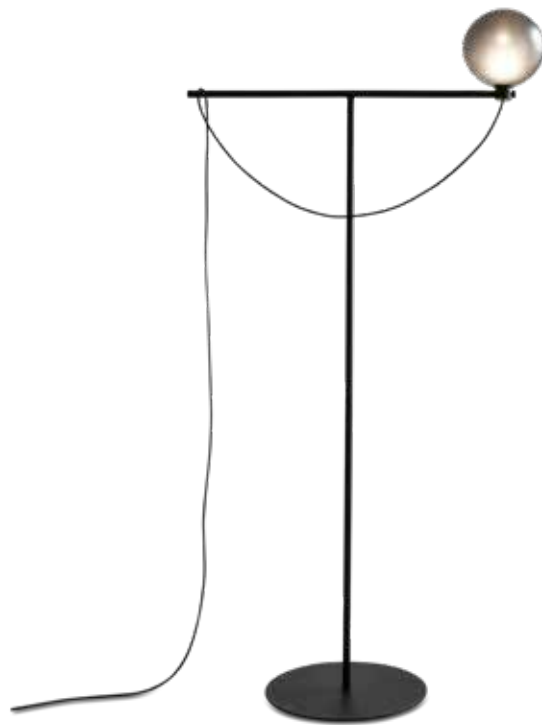


GLOBE FLOOR LAMP

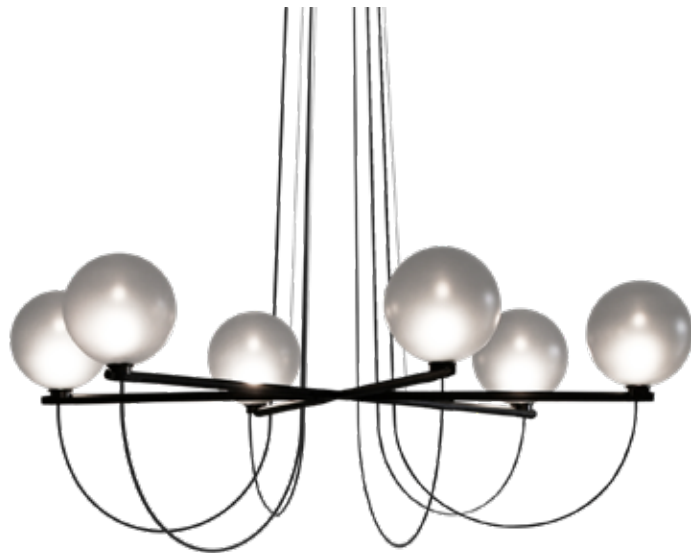


GLOBE CHANDELIER

MOODY, TACTILE & MYSTERIOUS

Inspired by a heroine of Camilla Stærk; Danish storyteller Karen Blixen, the tales from her life in Kenya during the 1920's and 30's and as accounted in her celebrated novels such as 'Out Of Africa'. The design of The Dark Spine Rug is an interpretation of a spine silhouette. Constructed of Pure New Zealand Wool, the tufted rug is made in Denmark. The design aims to speak to both the masculine and feminine. Not an overpowering feature, but an enticing addition to the surrounding settings; A complementary subtle design.

CLASSIC DESIGN WITH A MODERN PHILOSOPHY

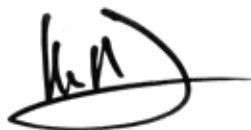
